

**Goolsby Elementary School Parent Leadership Team  
General Session Meeting Minutes  
Jan. 12, 2010**

Call to Order at 9:14 AM by Korrine Gentner. Board Members Kristen Shomer, Angie Phillips, and Jen Shenkberger were in attendance. Ms. Blume will be attending mid meeting. Laurie Crofton could not be here this AM as she started a new job. Thank you for attending.

**Old Business**

Ann Kroll said that the Winter Book Fair was a success. The school made \$1,200.00 over last years earnings. Thank you so much to all of the volunteers, you are always so appreciated.

**Principal's Report**

-Mrs. Blume says we did receive the \$8,000.00 for the Maintenance of Effort-Student Committee. There were only 4 schools that asked for it, so we did get it and have even asked for me. She will advise.

-The schools enrollment is high, but still only at 5% over capacity for a 9 month school. Goolsby is on a watch list for the district, if and when we get to 14% over capacity, we will be turned over to a 12 month school. At this point this is unlikely. Mrs. Blume will let us know as she knows; decision should be made by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010.

**Committee Chairperson's Reports**

Fundraising-Angie Phillips stated the Holiday Shop was less stressful then last year. Thank you to all of the volunteers, she could not have done it without you all. The school made some money and she will have a figure by next meeting. Next year she will be asking for a committee to head up the Holiday Shop to make it a much for fun experience for all.

Donna Hamrick spoke on Karrie Pebley and said we are down two people for traffic duty. They have since been replaced, but we are in need of more substitutes. She said Darren has agreed to put everything out needed for traffic. We need to take all back into him when finished with traffic.

Box Tops-Suzanne Reyes let us know that the last submission is end Feb. The class with 200 Box Tops gets free certificates to Golden Spoons. The classes with 500 get a popcorn party. There are still some awards to be given out for the last submissions; we are awaiting the teacher dates. We are thinking of a bigger award for the Feb. submissions. Each Pod will win something. Jessika Smaka is trying to get updated figures on what we have earned so far, the figure includes some of last year too. She said everyone needs to push the Albertson cards too. Goolsby can earn points from Albertsons all summer long.

Community Service-Stacy Aegerter said we will be doing Pennies from Heaven. This fund raiser takes 2-3 weeks and is to help the Lymphoma patients. It is not just for pennies, it is for all change.
