

Morning Drop-off Procedures

Gates open at 8:30

Morning Ceremony begins at 8:50



With 800+ students this year, there are many more families dropping off their children in the morning which means more traffic.

Therefore, it is important that our morning drop-off procedures are followed to ensure safety and efficiency. Please keep in mind that our number one goal is always the safety of our children.

When entering the school parking lot you have the option of parking and using the crosswalk to enter the school grounds or going through the drop-off lane, allowing your child to exit safely from your car.

The idea and purpose of the Drop-Off Lane is to allow as many cars in the unloading zone at once. Doors open, children exit, and the next group of cars are directed in. The Drop-Off Lane runs very smoothly when the instructions below are followed.

1. The UNLOADING ZONE begins at the corner of the Kindergarten playground marked “Carpool Lane Begins Here” and ends at the corner of the utility building just past the bike rack, marked “Drop-Off Here”.
2. When entering the UNLOADING ZONE, please pull forward to the farthest point possible.
3. When all cars have come to a complete stop, please have your child(ren) exit the car at that point in the line, on the **passenger side ONLY**. If this is not possible, please let a parent volunteer or teacher know and they will be happy to walk around your car to help. **Please DO NOT put your car in park and get out**, as this is a safety hazard and will only delay the entire line. If something is dropped or a door is not closed please advise and we will be happy to help. 😊

THINGS TO REMEMBER

1. Please make sure your child(ren) are ready and prepared to get out so as not to delay the line. Kisses and hugs at home, please; as well as back packs ready to go, shoes on and tied.
2. Should you have items in the trunk or the rear of your car please *park* in the parking lot and unload there.
3. Make sure to advise anyone that may be driving your child to school of the drop-off procedures.
4. **Please do not use the parking lot as a drop-off lane.** You may park in the parking lot and walk your child(ren) across the crosswalk.
5. **Always use the crosswalk.** Again, we want to teach our children safety.
